

#### **Sparkling Wine Helps Off-Premise Sales Grow 6%**

Both four-week and 52-week sales of domestic table and sparkling wine in off-premise locations grew 6% in value in July compared to a year ago, according to an analysis of data from IRI, the Chicago-based market research firm. Sparkling wine sales alone increased 9% in July and 8% in 52 weeks.



#### OFF-PREMISE SALES






### OFF-PREMISE SALES GROWTH RATE BY VARIETAL

Sauvignon Blanc had the fastest sales growth rate (from a smalll base) of any major varietal or type during the most recent 52-week period. Red blends/Meritage wines were close behind in growth percentage but from a much bigger base. These rates reflect domestic and imported wines combined.

Pinot Noir sales grew by 34% in the most recent 52 weeks, which was faster than all other major varietals or types in the \$20-plus per bottle segment, according to IRI. Six of the nine varietals shown grew in double digits.
